


Vocabulary

Fuel		Powers an engine
Steam Train		A train that is powered by a steam engine
Tractor		A powerful vehicle with large wheels used on farms.
Hot air Balloon		A large balloon that is filled with hot air and floats in the sky. There is a basket for people under the balloon.
Zebra Crossing		White stripes on a road where traffic must stop for people to cross.
Traffic Lights		A set of coloured lights that control traffic.



Fascinating Facts


1. The concord was the fastest plane in the world

5. Hot air balloons can't be used in the rain because the water would boil.




Phase 2 Sound Mat
